ATTENDANCE GUIDELINE - IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REGULATIONS

- Clinical sessions are held at a nursing facility.
- No absenteeism is permitted within the first sixteen (16) hours of instructions. After the first sixteen (16) hours of instruction, excused absences due to illness or family emergency may be permitted. Make up sessions are allowed to be scheduled up to a maximum of three (3) days.
- Beginning with the first session students are required to wear nonwhite uniforms/scrubs for all classroom and clinical sessions.
- Class requirements - one step negative TB test or proof of TB test within the past 12 months. TB test can be given in class for an additional charge of \$15.00.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations for all classes starting on Monday are accepted up to Thursday, 5:00 p.m. of the previous week.
